Jacob's Creek Chardonnay Pinot Noir

A mid straw green with a fine gas bead and persistent mousse. Generous citrus fruit flavours are enhanced with creamy nutty yeast characters providing both richness and structure. The wine finishes soft, crisp and clean. The refreshing lemon citrus aromas of Chardonnay are in harmony with the red currant characters of Pinot Noir.

Leo Buring Riesling

This wine is very 'expansive' on the palate, providing a rush of spicy lemon with hints of juniper berry. These flavours are carried along by a mouth-watering acidity on top of a very fine, talcy texture, that imbues incredible persistence and finesse.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Alkoomi Cabernet Sauvignon

Frankland River: WA

Consistently one of the better WA cabernets. It shows rich, intense, dark berry and cassis aromas with subtle cherry French oak overtones. The palate delivers a full bodied mix of sweet, dark cherry and chocolate fruits flavours with finely structured tannins. Handles savoury spicy food really well.

Pepperjack Cabernet Sauvignon

The Pepperjack Cabernet Sauvignon is plum red in the glass. Aromas of blackcurrants and spice develop into an elegant palate with a hint of mint and cedar. The rich full-bodied palate shows great structure and balance with a backbone of cedary oak and well-integrated tannins.
